

Sullivan Elementary PAC Meeting General

January 20, 2014

Meeting called to order at 6:35

1. **Review and Passing of December minutes:** 1st - Heather 2nd - Marle
2. **Review Agenda:** Additions, Deletions, and Deferrals: addition of Campbell's Soup Labels
3. **Principle Update:**
 - Al Pitchler will be doing auditions for grades 4-7 Feb. 28 and then if need be, for the lower grades; March 31 will be rehearsals; performances April. 29, 30
 - Book Swap: to be held next week; deadline to bring in books this Wednesday.
 - Parking: There are still complaints from neighbors re parking i.e. people are parking on both sides of culdesac, kids are coming out of cars on the street side and not the grass side. Kelly requesting that parents be more diligent and considerate when it comes to our neighbours and parking.
 - School Communication: Instead of having a separate PAC newsletter and school newsletter, they will both be combined into one letter; Sullivan Calendar will still be emailed every month. Newsletter will now be coming out the last Friday of the month.
 - Community Forum: February 24 7-830pm; Kelly will go with 3 parents.
 - New BC Curriculum: Kelly showed the BC government's page on the new proposed school curriculum. Sullivan isn't yet involved in the new report template; if and when Sullivan does participate in this, there will be parent feedback sessions, etc before it is rolled out.
 - Bell Centre is secured for December 10, 2014 for next year's Christmas concert.

5. **Jessie Miller Presentation:** will be booked again for May. Concern about the fact that last time he came, only 6 parents were there.
